



Regional Physical Activity Consultant (RPAC)

South Shore & Valley Regions

Contract Position: Immediately to March 31, 2027

This is an employment partnership between the Nova Scotia Department of Communities, Culture, Tourism and Heritage (Communities, Sport and Recreation Division) & Recreation Nova Scotia (RNS).

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide leadership and support to promote improvements in population levels of physical activity and support a culture of movement in South Shore and Valley regions of NS.
- Build capacity amongst diverse leaders and organizations within the regions, strengthening physical activity interventions and strategies. This includes but is not limited to Municipal/Mi'kmaw Physical Activity Leaders (MPALs), health promoters, Active Transportation professionals, Parks and Recreation professionals and volunteers.
- Advance regional and provincial priorities guided by the provincial strategy - *Let's Get Moving Nova Scotia*.
- Support communities and non-profit organizations access funding via Active Communities Fund.

What to expect and how to apply:

- Send a cover letter and resume as a single pdf to jobs@recreationns.ns.ca. Clearly state the job title in the subject line before the deadline (4.30pm AST, October 10th). Please include a cover letter that speaks to your experience and how this connects to the role.
- All applications will be closely reviewed by the hiring committee consisting of RNS and Communities, Culture, Tourism & Heritage (CCTH) staff.
- All candidates will receive an email at this stage to inform them if they have been selected to progress to the next stage.
- Selected candidates will proceed to an in-person interview with RNS and CCTH staff, in either Lunenburg or Kentville, anticipated to take place Friday, October 31 and/or Monday, November 3.
- RNS will conduct employment reference checks before presenting an offer to the successful candidate.
