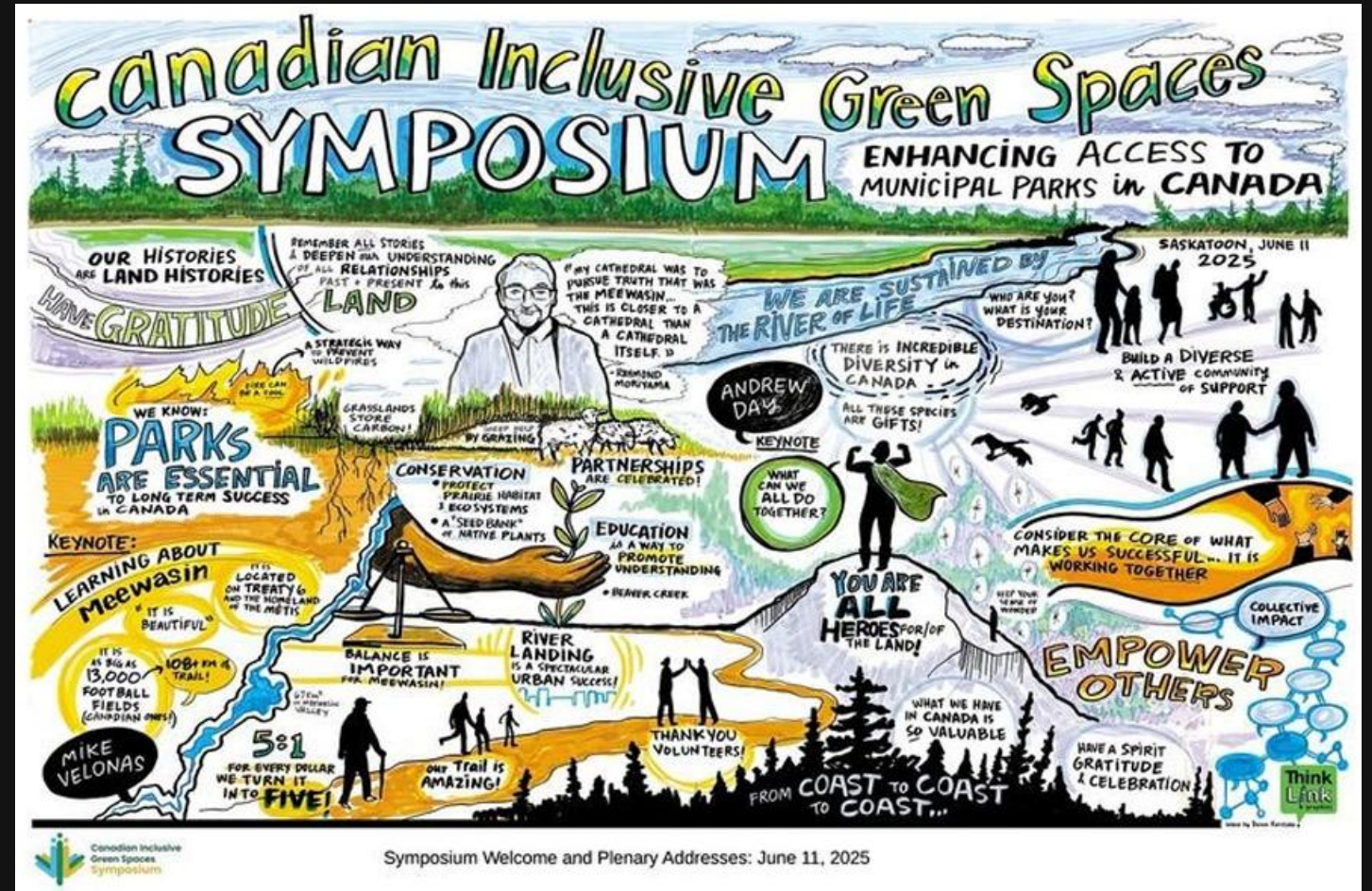
National Inclusive Green Spaces Symposium Recap

- Ways of Thriving: understanding that resilient lands and resilient communities are inseparable.



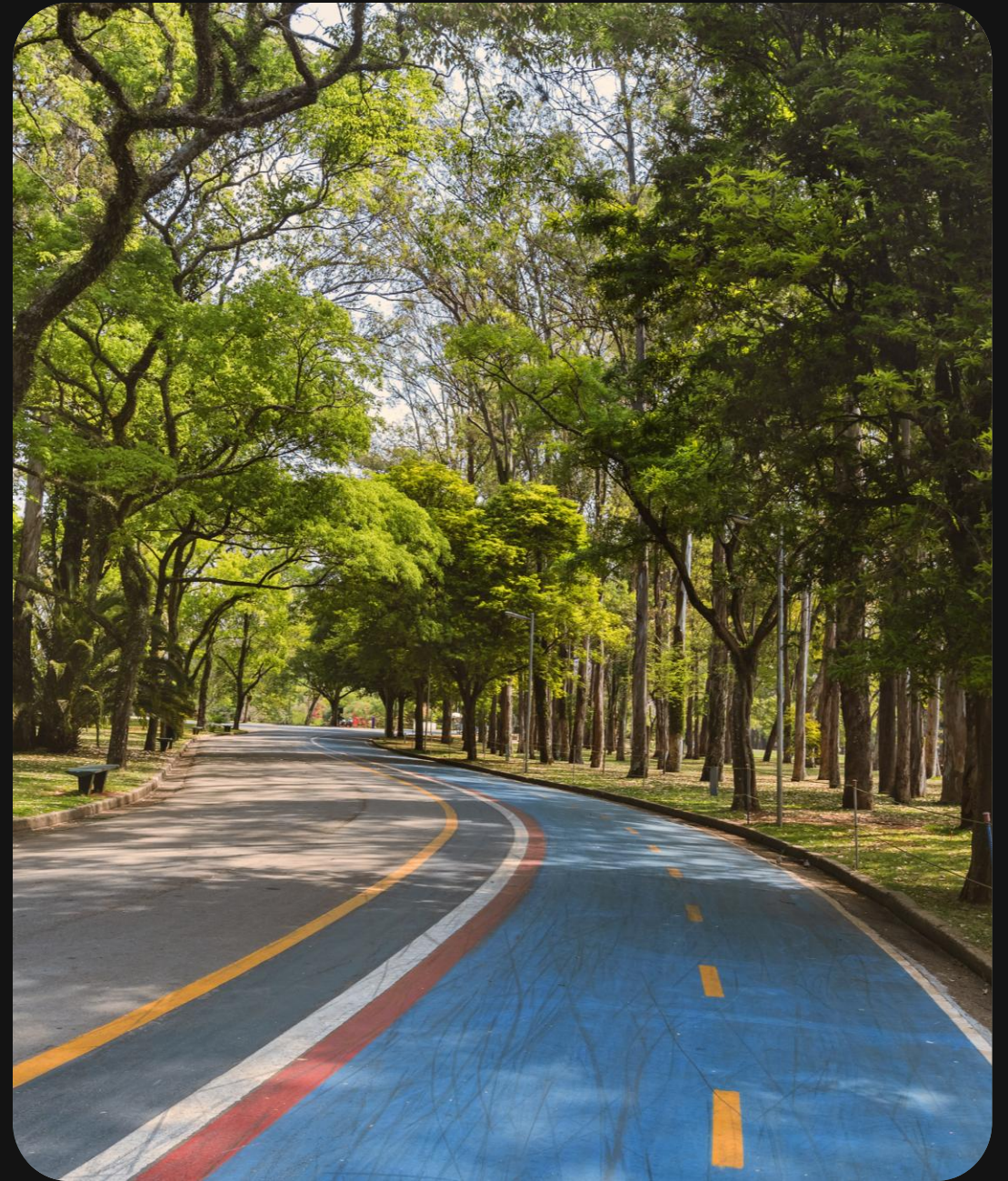
What did we learn?
